Guidelines:

- Plays, concerts, yearbook, class/school requirements, Pony Club, dancing, and other school club and performance activities are NOT eligible as volunteer hours.
- Students must complete a minimum of 80 volunteer hours.
- Students must complete a minimum of 3 volunteer hours supporting a SJISS fundraiser.
- No more than 8 hours credit is allowed within any 24-hour period.
- Students must volunteer for a minimum of 3 different organizations, not including SJISS.
